SENTENCING ORDER

The State of Indiana appears by Richard Joseph Hertel, Deputy Special Prosecuting Attorney, and the Defendant appears in person, and with counsel, Mark J Dove.

PLEA

The Defendant pleads guilty pursuant to: a written plea agreement which was accepted by the Court on the 11th day of May 2026. The Court enters Judgment of Conviction for the crime(s) of:

(684) Count (II) Forgery, a Level 6 Felony

The court finds the Defendant's plea to be knowing, intelligent, and voluntary and that there is a factual basis. The court finds the Defendant understands the nature of the charges, and that by pleading guilty the Defendant is knowingly waiving the following rights: to be represented by an attorney, or to have one appointed at no cost; to an early public jury trial in the county where the offense occurred; to remain silent, to be presumed innocent, to confront and cross examine witnesses, to subpoena witnesses to testify on behalf of the Defendant, and to appeal.

SENTENCING

Imprisoned at the Decatur County Criminal Justice Center
State moves to dismiss other counts, if any.

(684) Count (II), 730 days incarceration all suspended except (2) days, accrued time (1) days plus credit time (1) days. Suspended sentence to supervised probation.



Thereafter, any balance remaining is ordered released to the individual having posted the bond as evidenced by the bond sheet.

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10. You shall submit to random alcohol/drug screens as directed by your Probation Officer or at the direction of the call-in program at your own expense. An attempt to mask, dilute, or otherwise alter any test sample or screen will violate your probation and could result in additional criminal charges.
11. You shall not use any controlled substance, drug, intoxicant, or other mind-altering substance unless prescribed to you by a physician and then only in the manner the physician has ordered.
12. You shall submit to warrantless and/or suspicionless searches of your person, your residence, your motor vehicle, or your property by probation, law enforcement, or community corrections personnel at such times and places in the sole discretion of such personnel.
13. You shall successfully complete any education or treatment program that is deemed appropriate in a timely manner and at your own expense and sign any release of information for such program.
14. You shall abide by all Bureau of Motor Vehicles suspensions and/or restrictions including but not limited to terms of specialized driving permits.
15. You shall submit to DNA testing as required by law or requested by Probation.
16. Defendant shall not possess, directly or indirectly, any firearms or deadly weapons of any kind and such possession is a serious violation of probation.
